PUNI SCHOOL BAS1 - ENROLMENT SCHEME Policy

Rationale:

Puni School has an enrolment scheme to distinguish our enrolment zone and to prevent over-crowding at Puni School.

Guidelines:

1) Our Enrolment Zone is bordered by Waller Road, Wily Road down as far as Bregman Rd, AkaAka Road down as far as Elbow Rd, Settlement Rd, Tramway Rd, Attewell Rd bordering on Upper Queen St through to Kitchener Rd, Rowles Rd, Foy Rd, to Corbett Rd, Rogers Rd and up to 557 Waiuku Rd.

2) Criteria for Admission:

- **1. Priority One.** Automatic Entry as of Right:
- 1.1 Children who reside within the geographic area of Puni School, as detailed on the map held at Puni School, will have automatic entry. In cases where the geographic zone overlaps with the zone of another school the Board of Trustees recognizes that enrolment is a matter of parental choice.
- **2. Priority Two.** If places are available parents may request an enrolment under a Priority Two classification. Applications will be considered with regard to:
- 2.1 Children who live outside the geographic zone, but who have siblings attending Puni School
- 2.2 Siblings of former students who have attended Puni School.
- **3. Priority Three.** If places are available parents may request an enrolment under a Priority Three classification. Applications will be considered with regard to:
- 3.1 Children of Former Students
- 3.2 Children of Board Employees and Board Members
- **4. Priority Four.** If places are available:
- 4.1 All other students by ballot

3) Pre-enrolment:

Each year the Board of Trustees will:

- Determine a period during which applications will be accepted for the following year.
- Develop procedures to be followed in the application process.
- Specify the information which parents may be required to supply in support of an application for enrolment for the following year.
- 4) Applications will be accepted in terms of this scheme once it has been notified in accordance with Section 11G(6) of the education Act 1989. Ballot application forms are available in the school office or from our website www.puni.school.nz.
- 5) Puni School will hold ballot selections in accordance with MOE specifications.
- 6) From time to time where vacancies exist at certain levels enrolments may be accepted outside of ballot timetables.

Conclusion:

By enforcing an enrolment scheme and managing our growth, we will have spaces available for all children living within our zone to attend Puni School and class sizes will be kept to a reasonable teacher pupil ratio.
